- <u>Simile</u> comparison between two things using like or as. For e.g:- Sleek as a lizard.
- Metaphor an indirect comparison between two things.
 Generally, a quality is compared. For e.g:- "It is the engine of her family."
- <u>Personification</u> the attribution of personal nature characteristics to something non-human. For e.g:- The whole tree trembles and thrills.
- <u>Transferred Epithet</u> the figure of speech where the adverb is transferred to another noun. For e.g:- "her barred face identity mask."

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Poetic Devices

- Personification: The attribution of personal nature characteristics to something non-human. For e.g. 'I am the Poem of Earth, said the voice of the rain'.
- <u>Metaphor</u>: An indirect comparison between two things. For e.g. 'I am the Poem of Earth'.
- Imagery: Visual description of something. For e.g. 'Soft falling shower'.
- <u>Hyperbole</u>: Exaggerated statements. For e.g. 'Bottomless sea'.
- Inversion: A reversal of position, order, form, or relationship. For e.g. 'Said I to the soft - falling shower'.
